

Dive Club takes to the Skies

The Bainbridge Island Dive Club took to the skies to fly out to Boise, ID and compete in the Y Spring Classic diving meet this past weekend. This regional meet allowed the team's members from Bainbridge, Kingston and Poulsbo to showcase their abilities on both the 1 meter and 3 meter springboards against some very strong Pacific Northwest competition.

In the Girls 14-15 year old division Jackie Hellmers (Poulsbo) placed 2nd on the 1 M with a score of 194.50 and won a blue ribbon on the 3 M board with a score of 228.95. Zora Opalka (Bainbridge) earned a 2nd place on the 1 M board with a score of 334.50 and a 4th place finish on the 3 M board with a score of 339.15 in the Girls 16-18 year old division. Cammie Rouser (Kingston) also competed in the Girls 16-18 year old division and placed 4th on the 1 M with a score of 301.65 and came in 3rd on the 3 M springboard with a score of 350.45.

In the Boys 12-13 year old division Henry Sauermann (Bainbridge Island) took home a 2nd place finish on the 1 M where he scored 163.20 and on the 3 M board he took home a blue ribbon with a score of 190.40. Carter Wolff (Bainbridge Island) placed 1st on the 1 M with a score of 118.20 in the FC Level 4 boys division.

The team is looking forward to their next meet which is the US Diving Regional Championships in Beaverton, OR in late April.
